About Artery Wild Shapes Sculpture Exhibition

A nature-inspired sculpture opportunity for creative young minds, presented by Artery, held at Art Farm Birchs Bay.

Purpose & Vision

- To inspire children to explore their creativity through sculpture.
- To encourage connection with nature through looking at shapes and patterns in nature
- To celebrate imaginative play, hands-on learning, and environmental appreciation.

Who Can Enter

- Children aged 1 - 15
- Open to individuals or small group entries (e.g., school classes, family teams)
- No prior art experience required—just curiosity and creativity!

Parameters

- Sculptures must fit within and be presented within a 1kg Uncle Tobys Oats box. A name sheet must be attached to the back of the box.

Materials Guidelines

- Encourage use of natural, found, or recycled materials.
- Non-toxic, biodegradable, or repurposed supplies are welcomed.

Submission Requirements

- Sculpture dimensions: must fit within an Uncle Tobys oat box
- Completed entry form
- Submission deadline: **26 September 2025**
